Want to help inspire SAS students to succeed? Consider being a Junior Achievement volunteer!

Our volunteer-based K-8 Junior Achievement Program inspires kids to dream big and reach their potential while fostering work readiness, entrepreneurship, and financial literacy skills.

WHAT: This program is designed to help prepare students for the real world by teaching them how to generate wealth, how to effectively manage wealth, how to create jobs which make our communities healthier, and how to apply entrepreneurial thinking to the workplace.

HOW: Volunteers commit to spending 30-45 minutes in the classroom for 5 weeks. Each volunteer is provided with a kit of everything they need to run the classes – a detailed script of teacher speaker notes and all the supplies.

WHEN: Program begins the week of March 13, post Terra Nova testing. Each K – 5<sup>th</sup> grade volunteer coordinates a mutually agreeable time with the homeroom teacher. 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade volunteers coordinate with the Religion teacher, not the homeroom teacher. Before the program starts, an orientation will be hosted via zoom during the last week in February to review program specifics and to answer any questions you may have.

Students look forward to this fun, engaging, hands-on program each year! A volunteer with clearances is needed for each homeroom!
